# **BATHROOM FACILITIES**

All bathrooms are outfitted with 110-volt power outlets and sinks that provide hot and cold running water. In addition, they are well ventilated and acoustically insulated.

### **Toilets**

Our three modern porcelain toilets use fresh water and are truly state-of-the-art with electronic flush buttons. Unlike with most sailboats, you will not experience unpleasant odors from below.

#### **Showers**

Our two enclosed showers give you enough room to move comfortably about. They are smaller than you are used to at home but bigger than most sailboat showers. We have a third shower on deck for rinsing off after a swim. Hot and cold fresh water are instant and plentiful.

The bespoke fixtures are made of solid bronze. We chose tiled walls and floors accented with Carrara marble.

## **CABIN ARRANGEMENT**

Cabin 1 has two non-bunked twins. Cabin 2 is our single. Cabins 3, 4, and 6 feature bunked twins. Cabins 5, 7, 8, and 9 have gueens. If you have a specific cabin number in mind, just let us know when you book.
