Our cuisine reflects the restrained decadence and pure aesthetic of Maine.

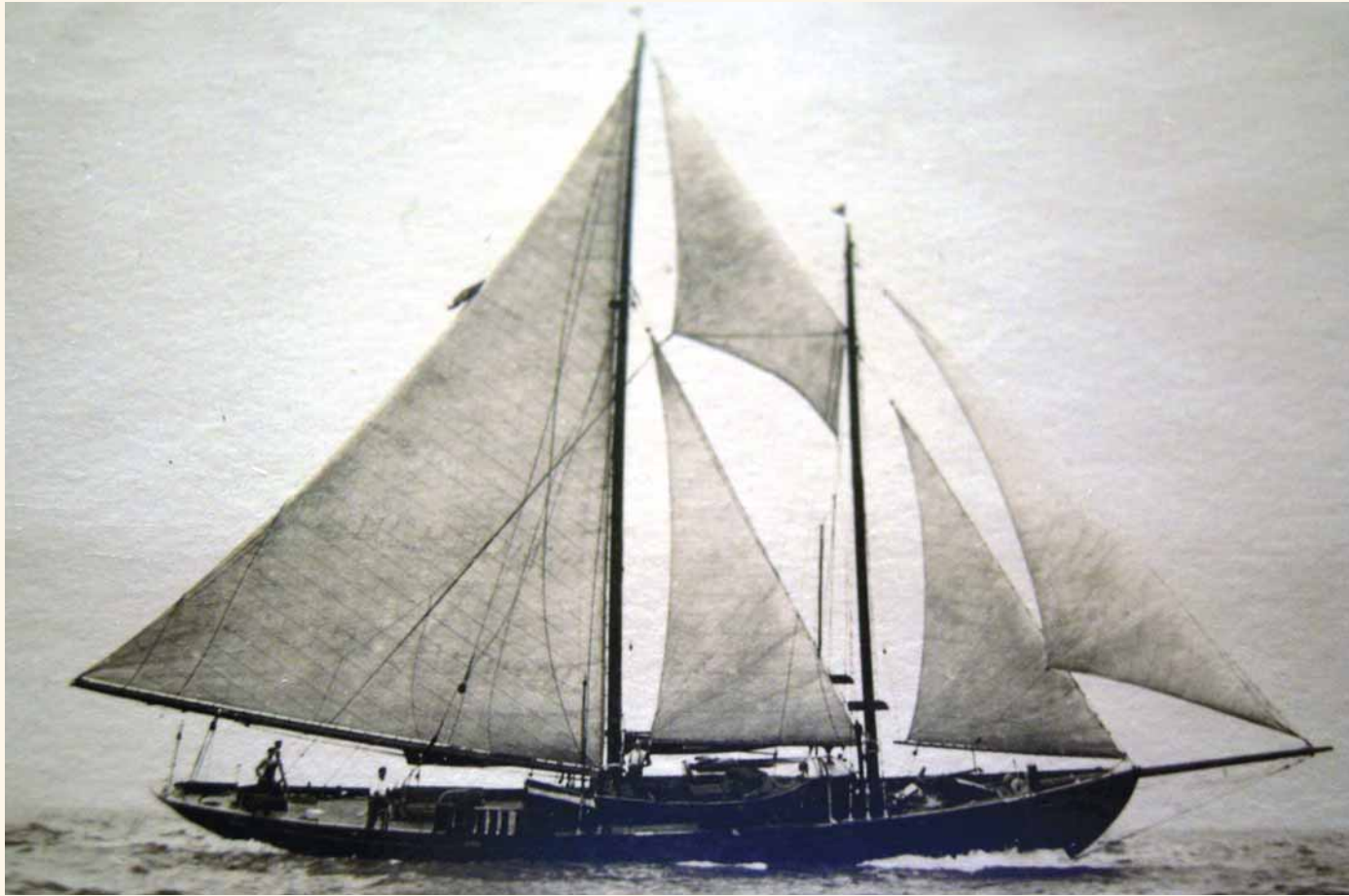

Ladona has been known for her beauty, swiftness, and strength since the day she was christened in 1922. Designed by William Hand and built as an elegant private yacht, she quickly proved her mettle as an ocean racer,

winning class honors in the Bermuda Cup in 1923. She served her country as a submarine patrol vessel during World War II, and later taught young sailors the ropes as a sail-training vessel.

Now fully restored after a painstaking refit, *Ladona* is designed for discerning tastes. There is much personal attention to detail and comfort, yet her aesthetic integrity and sailing ability still take your breath away.

- Three showers: one on deck for rinsing off after swimming, and two below decks

- Plenty of space to relax: 82 feet of classic schooner, sixteen guests, and five crew to attend to your needs

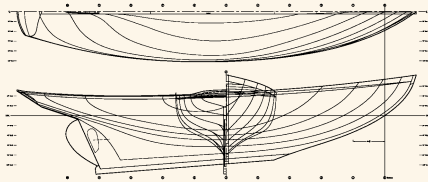
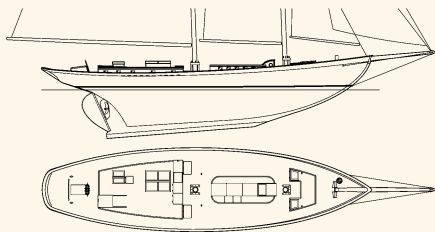

SHARED FACILITIES

With 82 feet of classic schooner and only 17 guests, you've got plenty of room to relax.

BATHROOM FACILITIES

All bathrooms are outfitted with 110-volt power outlets and sinks that provide hot and cold running water. In addition, they are well ventilated and acoustically insulated.

Toilets

Our three modern porcelain toilets use fresh water and are truly state-of-the-art with electronic flush buttons. Unlike with most sailboats, you will not experience unpleasant odors from below.

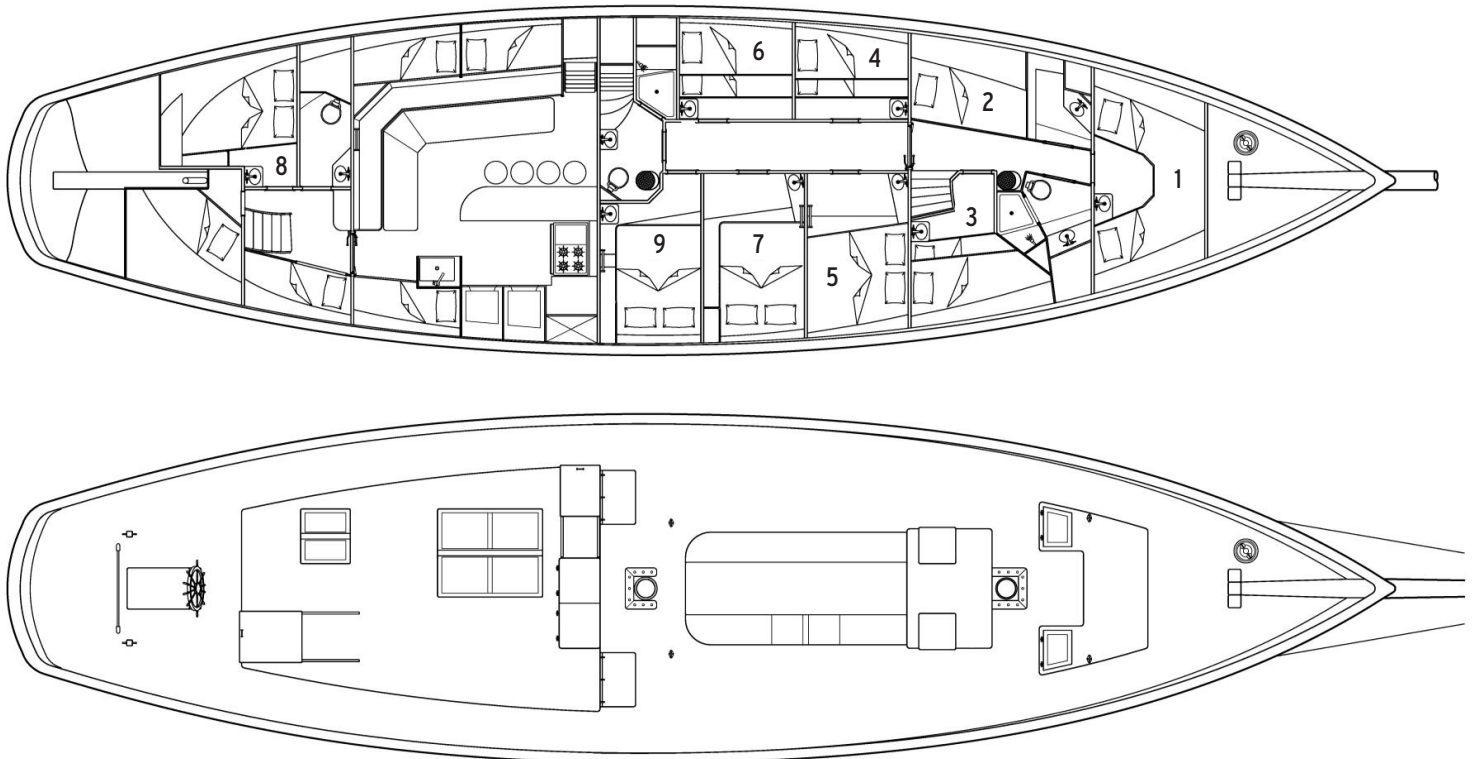
Showers

Our two enclosed showers give you enough room to move comfortably about. They are smaller than you are used to at home but bigger than most sailboat showers. We have a third shower on deck for rinsing off after a swim. Hot and cold fresh water are instant and plentiful.

The bespoke fixtures are made of solid bronze. We chose tiled walls and floors accented with Carrara marble.

CABIN ARRANGEMENT

Cabin 1 has two non-bunked twins. Cabin 2 is our single. Cabins 3, 4, and 6 feature bunked twins. Cabins 5, 7, 8, and 9 have queens. If you have a specific cabin number in mind, just let us know when you book.



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
